INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE: The Polaris Global Value UCITS Fund seeks capital appreciation by investing in value stocks worldwide. The Fund is diversified across country and market capitalization, and typically holds 65 to 100 stocks that meet Polaris' strict value criteria.

INVESTMENT STRATEGY: The Investment Manager uses proprietary investment technology combined with fundamental research to identify potential investments. Filters are applied as part of the investment approach, which attempts to identify a list of companies with the most undervalued streams of sustainable free cash flow worldwide. Polaris then conducts rigorous fundamental research on the companies identified in the screening process, selecting companies in which the Fund invests.

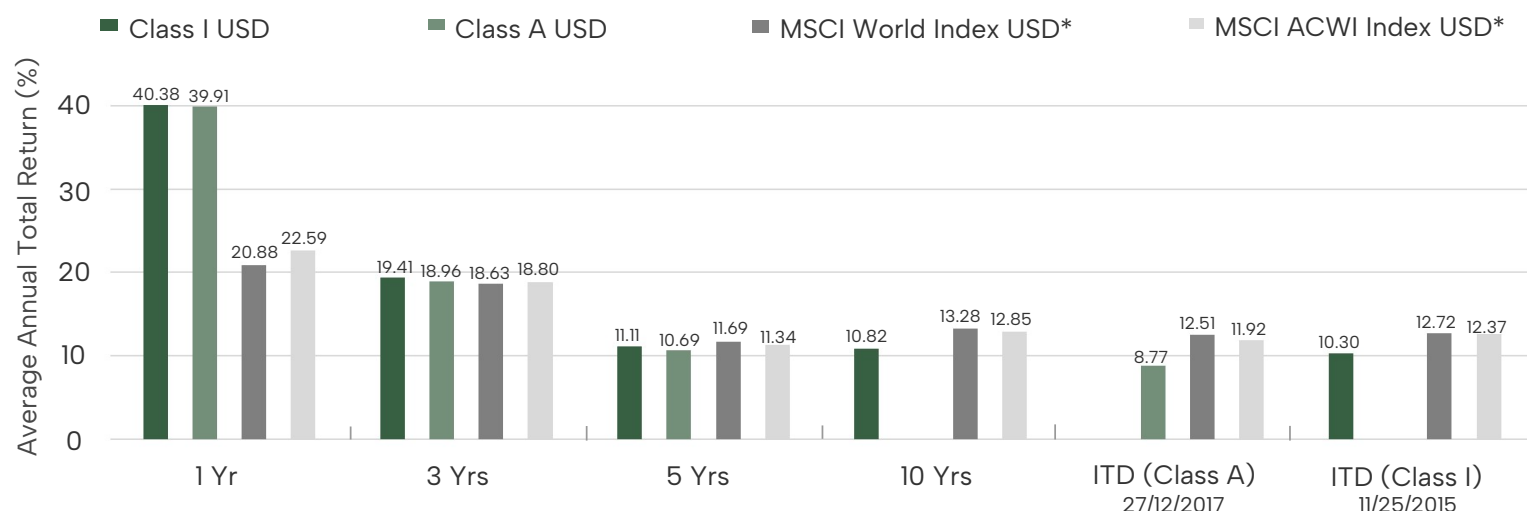
INVESTMENT MANAGER: Polaris Capital Management, LLC is a global value equity manager that provides investment services for institutional and individual clients. Polaris' view is that worldwide markets are generally efficient over time, but investor behavior creates volatility that leads to inefficiency somewhere in the world. Polaris believes that investing in the most undervalued companies worldwide likely limits risk and has the potential to outperform the benchmark.

INVESTMENT TEAM: The Fund is managed by a diverse team of 11 investment professionals.
